He graduated from the Ho Chi Minh University of Fine Arts, majoring in Oil painting, his painting focusing exploring personal perception, formed from the impact of education and daily routine in Vietnam Intrigued by the way our habits are taught, Đủ is drawn to the ethical and moral questions behind nationalism and the violence that often ensues its pursuit. Re-questioning the concept of ethics in animal violence and human consumption of animal meat. Pointing out the radical rob of natural resources by modernism - enhance awareness of the role of man towards nature – extends a spiritual invitation for us strive, in reflection and contemplation, towards unknown goals. His works majoritively in oil on canvas and watercolor on paper, sculpture, installation. However most recently he experiments with cow and human blood on various materials such as silk, canvas and paper.
